PLANNING COMMISSION

Current progress on town zoning and other plan commission activities were discussed during the annual meeting.

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

She had noticed numerous truck loads of fill being hauled to a property on Rocky lane and was wondering how this could be occurring given the temporary zoning moratorium. Board members were unaware of what was going on and Jay Teschke along with Marlin Noffke stated that they would check it out. Discussion was then held over material being taken out of Radloff's gravel pit, which is supposed to be shut down unless new permits are filed with the town.

Robert Liesner asked the board what the status of the South Highline ditching project. Brief discussion was held on the topic.

Jay made a motion to approve the St. Paul Spyrt Club to clean up the town's roadside ditches again this year for an estimated cost of \$1800. Frank seconded, motion carried.
