S Highline Sealed Bids

Bob Woldt presented a proposal from McMahan Associates, Inc. for the S. Highline Road Project for a total of \$26,850. This was the only bid received. Al made a motion, seconded by Tom to accept the bid. Motion carried. Surveying will begin in 2018 with road construction starting in 2019. Clerk to mail signed proposal to McMahan.

Clerk Report

Rhoda presented the DOR guideline that adding a 'covered service' (garbage fee) to a tax statement, would require reducing the tax levy by the same amount. There was a discussion on an increase in the levy to include an increase with a new garbage carrier if in fact there would be an increase and how to propose it at the Annual Budget meeting.

Vouchers and Bills to be Paid

Scott Schara requested this his quarterly pay fall on the same schedule as the rest of the Town Board as it is currently off by one month. Motion by Tom and seconded by Al to pay Scott for the one month he is behind. Motion carried.

Chairman/Road Report

After discussion of current road funds in budget, motion made by Bob and seconded by Tom that Old Dump Road will remain a gravel surface and receive asphalt in 2019. Motion carried.
